There are varied handicrafts such as: feather art, popular painting, resins and toys, elaborated with a great creativity, standing up the talent of our craftsmen.

















Pottery and ceramics

Handicrafts worked with mud and clay, finished with acrylic paints and anilines.

Pieces are fired at temperatures in the range of 800 ° C and 1200 ° C, obtaining glazes. This activity is developed by more than 2000 families in the State of Mexico.

Confectionery and traditional bread

The elaboration of sweets and bread with recipes inherited from generation to generation, have placed these products as true artisan delights.

Vegetable fibers

Through the gathering of different vegetable fibers, our craftsmen create a wide variety of products that decorate and facilitate activities of those who like them. Their beauty lies in tying, knotting and weaving this raw material.









Lapidary

This work demands from the craftsman not only strength, but also precision and talent to create architectonic ornamental pieces.

Woods

The carving and the wood work developed in the State of Mexico represents the tradition and history of our people, which is printed in contemporary products.

Metalwork

In the metalwork, we can appreciate handicrafts made of metal wire, hammered and embossed tins, where the craftsman creates ornamental and utilitarian pieces with excellent taste and delicacy.

Goldwork and jewelry

Silver and other metals are worked in the State of Mexico in the elaboration of Traditional Mazahua's Filigree, and these jewelry accessories are the emblem of the traditional ethnic iconography.



Paper and Cardboard Work

Giving shape to paper and cardboard into mystic characters such as "alebrijes" or into traditional pieces like "piñatas", make from these handicrafts, created by our hands, authentic works of art.

Pyrotechnics

Craftsmen from the State of Mexico have adopted this traditional technique where luminosity and coloring of "toritos", fireballs, rockets and "Judas" decorate festivities in and out of Mexico.

Leather work

This art is applied to pieces of clothing, implements of the artistic task as "charrería" and many other daily items, with the artisan touch of leather.

Textiles

Typical clothes made of wool and cotton with an important cultural legacy offering a wide variety of clothing and articles for the daily life.

Glass

Malleable material which is molded by craftsmen with talent and patience to create a great variety of shapes, figures and colors combined with a translucent essence of originality.

Bone and horn

Craftsmen of this branch create with bone and horn, small artistic replicas, innovative ornamental pieces and jewels for personal care.
